




PRICE OF MADE IN ITALY PRODUCT: GARDA PDO EXTRA VIRGIN OLIVE OIL – NOVEMBER 2019

MAIN FINDINGS FOR THE 2018/2019 SEASON:

- ✓ In contrast to the fall recorded in the national production of oil, the Garda PDO performed well in terms of both quality and quantity of production. As a result, there was no rise in the prices of the PDO oil.
- ✓ The average price of the Garda PDO extra virgin olive oil (computations on data from the Verona Chamber of Commerce) reached 10,75 €/kg, the low record after the 2015/2016 season and 13,7% lower than the level reached in the 2017/2018 season.
- ✓ The decrease recorded in the Garda PDO price along with the price rise of the conventional extra virgin oil, prompted by the sharp drop in the national production mentioned above, resulted in a lower price differential between the two, from 7,67 €/kg in the 2017/2018 season down to 5,65 €/kg in the following one.
